

General Directions for Table Top Quilts

(Finished size 9 ½" x 11 ½")

Patterns featured in McCall's Quick Quilts
November 2005 and September 2006 issues

Supplies:

Purchased 8" x 10" acrylic frame (Wal-Mart, A. C Moore, Office Depot)

Design front (pieced, paper pieced, appliquéd, any technique) 10" x 12"

Note: **Design needs to be smaller than 9" x 11".**

Quilt will be trimmed to 9 ½" x 11 ½"

If design is smaller than 9 ½" x 11 ½", add borders.

Batting (ex. Warm 'n Natural) 10" x 12"

Backing 10" x 12"

Flap on back 6" x 10" rectangle

Binding 2" strip WOF (width of fabric)

Directions:

1. Layer front, batting and backing. Baste. Quilt and embellish as desired.
2. Trim sandwich to 9 ½" x 11 ½".
3. Fold 6" x 10" rectangle in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, to make flap. Position long raw edges of flap even with top of quilt back, right sides together. Trim short edges even with quilt edges. Baste or pin in place.
4. Apply binding, handling flap as part of the quilt back.
5. Slip flap over top of frame.
